



CARING FOR YOUR METAL PARTIAL DENTURE

HOME CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Your metal partial denture, like your own teeth, require care and good oral hygiene. To keep your metal partial denture looking and feeling like new, please follow these simple directions:

- 1) **Clean** your partial denture regularly with a denture brush and non-abrasive cleanser. Be careful to brush gently to avoid bending the clasps.
- 2) **Rinse** your partial denture under running water after eating to remove any food particles. A sonic denture cleaner may also be used.
- 3) **Keep your partial denture in water** whenever it is not being worn to keep the surface hydrated.
- 4) **Soak the appliance** in denture cleaner for 10-15 minutes each day, or overnight at least three times per week if it collects heavy deposits of calculus/tartar.
- 5) **Remove the appliance** before brushing your natural teeth and gums or rinsing with mouthwash
- 6) **Do NOT** use alcohol, abrasive cleaners, bleaches, whiteners, Listerine, etc. as they may breakdown or scratch the surface of the denture. Harsh products like bleach will turn the pink parts of your denture white.
- 7) **Avoid** brushing your partial denture. This is **NOT** recommended as this may remove the polish and roughen the surface over time.
- 8) **Do NOT** use boiling water, the dishwasher, or the microwave to clean or soak your dentures because it will warp them.
- 9) Please keep your **regular dental appointments** and remember to always bring your partial denture with you for routine evaluation.
